



In drama class we expect to learn, explore, and have fun. Our goal is to develop students' skills and refine their abilities in all areas of drama. Our productions are outgrowths of what we have learned. However, memorization of lines and practice of dramatic gestures will be expected of all students.

This semester our play will be '**Rumpelstiltskin**.' It will be produced on **Friday, May 15th**. Auditions will begin Jan 28th. All paper work must be turned in prior to auditioning. We try to provide your costume for the show from the Drama Closet; however, you will be responsible for some pieces of your costume. Costume fittings will occur after school on March 24th during Advisory on March 23rd or March 25th. Following your fitting, you will be given a list of items you need to provide for your costume. These items may be as difficult as a suit coat or as simple as a pair of socks. All final pieces of your costume are due on April 16th.
